Sunday Morning Faith Formation Opportunities for All Ages (10:10-10:50)

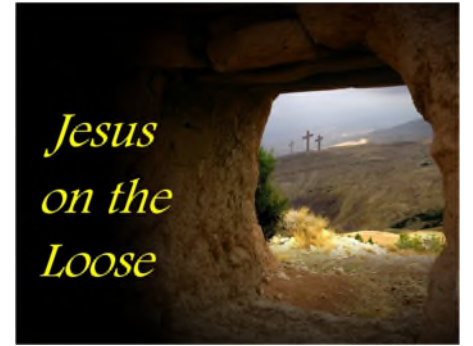
Disciples in Training is for all children ages 4 years old through 6th grade. This year's theme is Fruits of the Spirit (meets starting at 10am in downstairs classrooms)

Wired Word discusses current events in a Scriptural framework and how the scriptures provide guidance to being in the world. (Meets in the library)

Men's Group is a place for men of all ages to gather in the Word and fellowship. (Upper Room, use stairs by the Sanctuary)

Women's Group is a place for women of all ages to gather in the Word and fellowship. The current topic is using the enneagram to develop your spirituality and connection to God. (Chapel of Grace across from Family Lounge)

Central Road will be closed from Reynolds to Corey until 9:00. Dorr will be closed from UT to Richards until the end of the Race. The village service department will be placing cones in the parking spaces on Indian to reserve the parking for us. You can move a cone to park if need be. **The best way to get to Hope is to come south on Secor from 475 or Monroe for the 9AM service. For the 11:00 AM you can come via Central to Indian or Secor. Do not plan on using Bancroft or Dorr to come from the west or south!**
