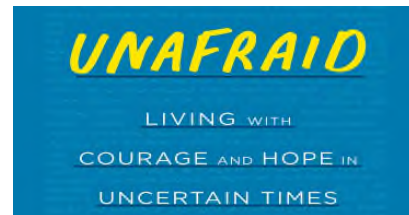
- Re-read the Scripture found in Genesis 2:15-24
