Sunday Morning Faith Formation Opportunities (10:10-10:50)

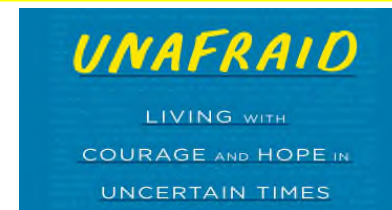
