Sunday Morning Faith Formation Opportunities (10:10-10:50)

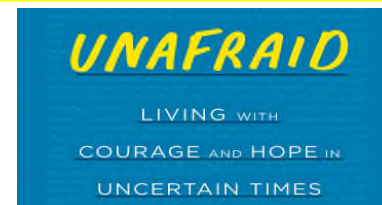
Disciples in Training and the women's group will begin again in the fall. Wired Word and the Men's group will continue to meet throughout the summer, in the library and the upper room respectively.
