## Welcome to Hope Lutheran Church!

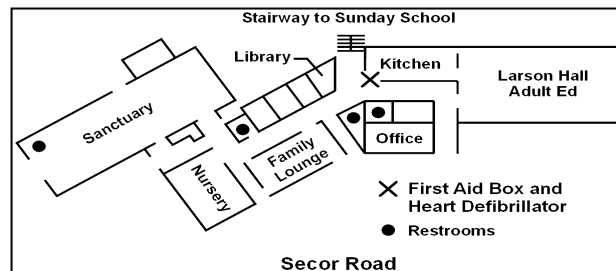
- If you are a guest this morning, please notice the staff and lay leaders wearing identification badges. They will be able to assist you.

## Sunday Faith Formation

**10:00am – 10:50am: Disciples in Training** is for all children ages 3 years old through 6<sup>th</sup> grade. This year's theme is "Into the Wilderness with God" and all children are welcome to join us downstairs .
