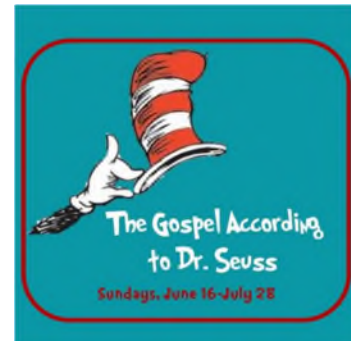

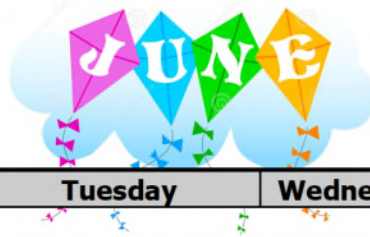
Interfaith Blood Drive
